

STEWARDS REPORT

City Of Dubbo Turf Club DUBBO RACECOURSE

Saturday 3rd November 2018

Weather: Fine.
Track: Soft (5), upgraded to Good (4) at 1:42pm following Race 1.

RACE 1: DUBBO TELSTRA MAIDEN HANDICAP 1000M:

GET UP ALBY – Crowded shortly after the start by *Royal Swagger* which shifted in.

TROJAN – Bumped shortly after the start by *Ben Shoof* which began awkwardly. Laid in under pressure near the 200m and momentarily crowded *Dusky Damsel*.

MISS ACADEMY – App Ms K Jenkinson replaced App Ms W Peel (transport difficulties) as the rider of the filly. Near the 100m commenced to lay out under pressure bumping with and carrying wider *Cutie Patoutie* which then bumped with *Pellizena* which was steadied.

AMELDA – Laid out under pressure over the final 100m and *Trojan* which was attempting to improve to its outside was obliged to shift wider to improve. *Caszar* was also obliged to shift wider to improve around the heels of *Trojan*. App Q Yong was advised that he must stop riding and straighten his mounts when they are shifting ground.

TICKETS LADIES – Checked near the 500m after improving onto the heels *Bless My Boots* which had been restrained after hanging out.

RACE 2: THE ROYAL INDIAN RESTOBAR MAIDEN PLATE 1400M:

REGAL CANNON – Held up rounding the home turn and early stages of the straight on the heels of *Kalisa's Secret*.

RUFIO – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

FLEUR DE FORCE – Near the 1100m was steadied when crowded by *Ruffio* which was taken in by *Southern Strategy* (A Robinson) which shifted in. A Robison was reprimanded (AR137a)

GEEGEE BOOM – Near the 500m was steadied when crowded inside *Kalisa's Secret* which was bumped inwards by Lolly.

EL REY DORADO – when questioned regarding the improved performance trainer Ms K Lunn stated that in her opinion the addition of blinkers to the gelding's official gear as well as a drop back in distance attributed to the improved performance. Ms Lunn also added that the gelding was benefited from being able to maintain his momentum throughout the race.

MISS DONAI – A post race veterinary examination of the mare which was beaten 27.77L failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer Mr M Lunn was advised that **Miss Donai** would be required to prove its competitiveness in a barrier trial before being permitted to race again.

RACE 3: SJ SHOOTER REAL ESTATE CLASS 1 & MAIDEN PLATE 1400M:

CHUR BRO – Crowded shortly after the start by Catwalk Queen which shifted in. A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

CLUB TOWN – R Brewer pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 12 occasions prior to the 100m. R Brewer's license to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence on 12/11/18 and to expire on 19/11/18 on which day he may ride.

FESTIVAL OF LIGHT – Overraced in the early and middle stages. Near the 150m was steadied when crowded by *Bolly* which laid in.

BOLLY – Reared on jumping and lost ground.

SACRED PEAK – A post race veterinary examination of the mare failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

SORRY I'M AWESOME – A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

RACE 4: CLUB DUBBO BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP 1000M:

CADMAN – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

TAKING LIBERTIES – A post race veterinary examination revealed a slower than normal recovery. Trainer Ms G Williams advised that the mare would now be spelled.

TULLY HO – Near the 950m was steadied when crowded by *Taking Liberties* which shifted in away from *Snippety Snip*. Near the 800m was steadied when crowded by *Taking Liberties* which was carried in by *Shadow Force* (App Ms K Jenkinson) which shifted in when not clear. App Ms K Jenkinson was reprimanded (AR137a).

SNIPPETY SIP – Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post race veterinary examination of the gelding revealed it to be 1/5 lame in the near fore leg. Trainer Mr C Lundholm advised that the **Snippety Snip** would now be spelled.

LUCKY ASSASSIN – A pre race veterinary examination passed the gelding fit to start.

RACE 5: CENTRAL WEST MCHAPPY DAY BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP 1400M:

ANY BLINKIN' DAY – Overraced in the early stages and raced wide throughout.

SEA LADY – Near the 400m laid in onto the heels of *Zoutenant* and was unable to obtain completely clear running until near the 300m due to the mare continuing to lay in. Near the 250m was bumped by *Nordic Noir* which laid in and placed Sea Lady back onto the heels of Zoutenant where **Sea Lady** was then shifted to the inside of the heels of *Zoutenant* to improve. Shortly after shifting in **Sea Lady** was disappointed for a run between *Zoutenant* and *We Love Rugby* and was then shifted back outward into clear running. When questioned regarding his riding and the performance of the mare rider G Ryan stated that he settled back as is the mares usual racing pattern. G Ryan added that on straightening he attempted to shift out underneath *Nordic Noir* and the mare was reluctant to do so and laid in. He further added that **Sea Lady** continued to lay in when he was attempting to shift out to improve and in his opinion was reluctant to push into narrow running. G Ryan also added that once clear over the final 100m his mount only laboured to the line and may have been burdened by the 60.5kg it had to carry today. Mr B Thompson will be interviewed regarding the mares racing manners.

SUPER CHASE – A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

JEMILY – K Dunbar replaced R Brewer (indisposed) as the rider of the mare. A post race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame 1/5 in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr A Palmer was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required before the mare is permitted to race again.

THE FRICK – Slow to begin.

RACE 6: DUBBO CITY TOYOTA BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP 1600M:

CEASELESS – Near the 350m laid out and bumped *Zaphod*. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer Mr D Considine advised that the gelding would now be spelled.

ZAPHOD – A post race veterinary examination revealed a slower than normal recovery.

GEORGE TWO – G Ryan replaced R Brewer as the rider of the gelding. Began awkwardly.

QUIETLY CONFIDENT – Slow to begin.

OLIVARES – When questioned rider M Cahill stated that the gelding travelled well until near the 600m where it was immediately under pressure and failed to run on as expected. M Cahill added that his mount changed strides on several occasions when under pressure and in his opinion did not feel comfortable in its action. A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer Mr M Rumble advised that it would now be his intention to spell **Olivares**.

RACE 7: MAAS GROUP FAMILY PROPERTIES CLASS 1 HANDICAP 1200M:

REWARD THE CHASER – Hung out rounding the home turn and when under pressure in the straight. Trainer Mr B Cavanough was advised that a warning would be recorded against the manners of the gelding.

COURT IN CAMERA – A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

INVINCIBLE TYPE – When questioned regarding the performance of the mare rider M Cahill stated that after being fractious in the barriers the mare failed to travel comfortably at any stage of the race and in his opinion felt short in its action. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer Mr C Crockett stated that he had expected the mare to perform well today and undertook to report on the condition of the mare in the days subsequent to the meeting.

LATE RETURN – Laid out under pressure in the straight.

POPPY'S FRECKLE – Slow to begin.

TROPICANA LASS – Ms E Webster-Hawes replaced R Brewer as the rider of the mare. Began awkwardly and shifted out crowding *Zarwinkles*.

FUTURE ROAD – Late scratching at 5:06pm by order of stewards after becoming fractious in the mounting yard and dislodging rider K Dunbar before escaping the mounting yard and returning to the day stall area. Stewards ordered that all bets placed on **Future Road** be refunded and all successful bets placed on the race with bookmakers prior to 5:06pm be paid less the following deductions in the dollar on the face value of the ticket. Trainer Mr B Thompson was advised that a warning would be recorded against the mare.

1st – *Reward the Chaser* – 5 cents win

2nd – *Late Return* - 5 cents place
 3rd – *Arctic Warrior* - 6 cents place

ZARWRINKLES – Near the 50m was steadied after improving onto the heels of *Invincible Type*.

ARCTIC WARRIOR – Began awkwardly.

General:

Samples were obtained from **all** winners.

Summary of whip use.

Stewards noted the following riders exceeded the permitted strikes of the whip prior to the 100m under AR137A(5)(a)(ii). Bearing in mind the totality of whip use, no action was taken.
