RACE 1: FAIRFOX MARKETING SERVICES CG&E MAIDEN PLATE 1200M:

CASULA LAD – A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

BLINKIN' LUCKY – Slow to begin.

RACE 2: THE DUBBO DOMAIN F&M MAIDEN PLATE 1200M:

ALPINE ROYAL – Hung out rounding the home turn and when under pressure in the straight. Near the 50m laid out and bumped with *You Know Zon*.

ARROW HAZE – Near the 1000m laid in and bumped with *On the Delta* resulting in both horses becoming unbalanced.

BLINKIN FLYING – Trainer Mr C Lundholm was advised that the mare which was beaten 20.41L would be required to barrier trial to satisfaction of stewards before being permitted to race again.

MARADA – Shortly after the start was checked when crowded by *Arrow Haze* which shifted in away from *Alpine Royal* (R Yetimova) after initially being carried in by that runner. R Yetimova was reprimanded (AR137a).

RACE 3: THE DAILY LIBERAL BENCHMARK 50 HANDICAP 1200M:

COROGLLEN – To be ridden further back. Settled off pace. Near the 50m was steadied when crowded by *Leap of Legend* (App Ms A Stanley) which shifted out under pressure. App Ms A Stanley was reprimanded (AR137a).

LEAP OF LEGEND – Slow to begin. App Ms A Stanley was fined \$200 AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip 10 times prior to the 100m.

DRUMMED OUT – When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding rider A Cavallo stated that the gelding overraced in the early stages but near the 500m was immediately under pressure and found very little when weakening in the straight. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a poor post race recovery. Trainer Mr P Reynolds was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required before Drummed Out is permitted to race again. Mr Reynolds advised that it would now be his intention to freshen the gelding.

RACE 4: THE MAILBOX SHOPPER BENCHMARK 50 HANDICAP 1600M:

UNRESOLVED – Penalised 2kg after winning at Dubbo on 3/11/18. Slow to begin.

TRUST ME BILL – Laid in passing the 100m.

BARADINE BOUND – Shortly after the start clipped the heels of Trust Me Bill and blundered after Trust me Bill had been carried out by Shake Off which shifted out.

RACE 5: THE WESTERN MAGAZINE CLASS 2 HANDICAP 1400M:

PRIOR ENGAGEMENT – A post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

NINO – Overraced in the early stages.

ALLISAM – Slow to begin.

DECADES – Slow to begin.

General:

Samples were obtained from **all** winners.

Trainer Mr P Stanley was reprimanded AR175q regarding his improper conduct during the course of an inquiry following race 3.

Summary of whip use.

Stewards noted the following riders exceeded the permitted strikes of the whip prior to the 100m under AR137A(5)(a)(ii). Bearing in mind the totality of whip use, no action was taken.
