

STEWARDS REPORT

Tweed River Jockey Club MURWILLUMBAH RACECOURSE

Race 1: Benchmark 50 Handicap 1010m:

Cinnabon – Rider A. Chau pleaded guilty to charge under AR137(a) in that near the 800m did permit his mount to shift in across the running of **Cinnabon**, resulting in that runner clipping heels and becoming unbalanced. A. Chau's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence on 9th November 2018 and to expire on 20th November 2018, on which day he may ride.

Conquers All – Began awkwardly.

Le Charioteer – Steadied near 800m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have bled from both nostrils. Trainer Mr. D. Dwane was advised that **Le Charioteer** would now incur the embargoes under AR53A.

Schopenhauer – Near 800m had to be steadied off the heels of *Cinnabon*.

Race 2: Maiden Plate 1200m:

Charlua – Inclined to hung out rounding the home turn and in the early part of the straight.

Sideshow AI – Slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Storm's Coming – Crowded on jumping and then slow into stride.

Yoshiko – Inclined to lay out under pressure over the final 200m.

Race 3: Maiden Plate 1530m:

Averna Mountain – Raced wide throughout. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Iberian Lace – OVERRACED in the early stages.

Look Out Boy – OVERRACED in the early stages.

Seven Rubies – A post-race veterinary examination of the mare failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Wishbeats – Slow to begin.

Race 4: Benchmark 45 Handicap 1530m:

Happy Room – Slow to begin.

Noreena – Raced keenly in the early stages. Near 1200m laid out across heels and had to be steadied.

Race 5: Benchmark 45 Handicap 2000m:

Bramwell – Was declared at 4:21pm by order of stewards, after the mare was unable to load. Stewards ordered that all monies wagered on **Bramwell** be refunded in full and all successful wagers placed with bookmakers prior to 4:21pm be subject to the following deductions:

1st *Prince Morpheus* less 33 cents win.

Trainer Ms. V. Chalmers was advised the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing again.
