

**Stewards Report

Monday 9th July 2018**

Weather: Fine

Track: Good (4)

Rail: +3m from 1000m to the 275m then cutaway.

Stewards: J T Penfold (Chairman) and S P Fitzgerald

Supplementary: Trainer Ms M O’Gorman was fined \$200 for using an unregistered stablehand. (LR82)

Race 1: Maiden Handicap 1000m

Kentucky Dubleo – Slow to begin.

Race 2: Maiden Plate 1200m

Mr Butcher – Had to be steadied over the concluding stages.

Cocky Rocky – Was checked shortly after the start when crowded between runners. Hung out rounding the home turn.

Little Geoffrey – Was held up rounding the home turn and did not obtain clear running until the 300m.

Aubrey Skies – Bumped on jumping.

Keeva – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

Highton – Over raced in the middle stages, then shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

Magic Anna – Crowded on jumping.

Race 3: Class 1 Plate 2100m

Lithely – Was a late scratching on veterinary advice after it was found to have been kicked by another runner in the race day stalls.

Teranupthegarden – Was bumped on jumping. Trainer Mr P Grills was advised that the gelding must perform competitively in an official barrier trial prior to racing again.

Alanton’s Philly – Began awkwardly.

Race 4: Maiden Set Weights 1600m

Terrigal – Fell shortly after the winning post and dislodged the rider J Hull. He was assessed by the ambulance officers on course and had general soreness to his legs, he was cleared to fulfil his engagements. After viewing the

available patrol footage, it was ascertained that J Hull lost the use of his off side iron. The horse was also cleared of any injury.

Palace Street – A warning was placed on the gelding's record for hanging out in the home straight. After passing the winning post, clipped the heels of another runner and dislodged the rider Ms C Graham. She was assessed by the ambulance officers and was found to have general soreness but was cleared to fulfil her remaining engagements. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be sore over the back. Trainer Mr M Dobie advised that *Palace Street* will be transferred out of his racing stable. A veterinary certificate of fitness is required prior to *Palace Street* being able to race again.

Race 5: Class 2 Handicap 1400m

Roboosto – Bounded on jumping.

Onya Rosie – Slow to begin.

My Valore – A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery.

Leave Ya Numba – Over raced in the early stages.

Cricklewood – Was crowded passing the 800m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed nil abnormalities.

Making Shadows – Had to be restrained momentarily passing the 800m.

Race 6: Benchmark 65 1200m

Cheljoe – Slow to begin.

Boolaroo – Slow to begin.

Col's Tiger – Bumped on jumping.

Exotic Fever – Bumped on jumping.

He's Our Toy Boy – Over raced in the middle stages.

Race 7: Class 3 1000m

Private Ryan – Slow to begin. A warning for poor performance was placed on record. Trainer Mrs D Wilson advised that *Private Ryan's* next start will be at a non-tab venue.

Dead Reckoning – Hampered on straightening, then hung out over the concluding stages.

Not In The Nick – Over raced in the early stages.

Tango Time – Raced in restricted room rounding the home turn.

Swab samples were obtained from all winners.

Summary of whip use:

Stewards noted the following riders exceeded the permitted strikes of the whip prior to the 100m under AR137A(5)(a)(ii). Bearing in mind the totality of whip use, no action was taken.
