

## STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

#### **RACE 1: Eve O'Brien Properties 2YO & 3YO Maiden Plate 1200m**

**Juliet's Dream** – Trainer Ms N Jarvis was fined the sum of \$50 under LR35 for the late declaration of app A Kajiya as the rider of the filly. Shifted out on jumping.

**Sunday Poet** – Slow to begin. Ran out abruptly passing the 100m. Trainer Ms T Bateup was advised that a warning would be recorded against the racing manners of the gelding.

**Boston Ivy** – Began awkwardly resulting in its rider B Owen becoming unbalanced. Passing the 600m was restrained after becoming awkwardly positioned close to the heels of Sunday Poet.

#### **RACE 2: Schute Bell Badgery Lumby & Monaro Wool Maiden Handicap 1400m**

**Purple Over Green** - Began awkwardly.

**Graceful Gift** – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

**Extra Cool** – Began awkwardly , shifted in and made contact with Captain Ryder.

**Lady Juiana** – App A Sweeney (Supa Hong Kong) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding in that passing the 1000m he made insufficient effort to prevent his mount, which was inclined to lay in, from shifting in resulting in Glasgow Grey being carried in resulting in Lady Juiliana having to be restrained when crowded for room and ultimately losing its rightful running. App A Sweeney's permit to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence immediately and to expire on Tuesday 19 June 2018 on which day he may ride. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the straight. Raced greenly in the straight.

**Glasgow Grey** – A post-race veterinary examination of the filly did not reveal any abnormality. Following this event rider R Bensley requested the attention of the ambulance officers due to migraine. R Bensley was subsequently cleared to fulfil his remaining riding engagements.

**RACE 3: Carpet Court Benchmark 59 Handicap 1400m**

**Lauriz** – Raced wide throughout.

**Newtown Is Coming** – Slow to begin.

**Dream On Stan** – Slow to begin.

**Unruly Student** – Began awkwardly.

**RACE 4: Pat Nevill's Twofold Security Services Benchmark 55 Handicap 1000m**

**Saarim** – Slow to begin.

**She's Got Bling** – Heavily bumped on jumping between Bilby and Jewel Of The Clan both of which shifted ground. In the incident Bilby became unbalanced.

**Jewel Of The Clan** – When questioned regarding the performance of the filly, rider R Bensley stated that after his mount began awkwardly and bumped Bilby on jumping, it then did not show its customary early speed, did not travel at any stage of the event and proved most disappointing in the run to the line. A post-race veterinary examination of the filly did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer Mr N Olive advised that the filly would now be sent for a spell. Mr Olive was told that the filly would be required to barrier trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to resuming. Following his ride, R Bensley complained of the continuation of his migraine and was stood down from his remaining riding engagement.

**That's The Ticket** – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have been galloped on behind.

**Bilby** – Bumped on jumping and became unbalanced. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have been galloped on on its off-foreleg.

**RACE 5: Momson Motors Merimbula Jazz Cup 1600m**

**Treaty Of Paris** – As J Devrimol was overweight, Stewards permitted S Pollard to be substituted as the rider of the gelding. J Devrimol was fined the sum of \$100 under AR120(b)).

**Gentleman Max** – Slow to begin. Over-raced in the middle stages. Over the concluding stages was restrained when tightened for room by Ziganui (B Ward) which shifted in when not clear. B Ward was reprimanded (AR137(a)).

**Don't Shoot** – Raced wide throughout.

**Gentle Annie** – Near the 1200m when the pace slackened, had to be shifted out when awkward on the heels of Ziganui and when Nagging then improved to its inside was obliged to race three wide for the remainder of the event.

**RACE 6: Eve O'Brien Properties Jazz Festival Sprint 1200m**

**Janis** – As R Bensley was stood down due to a migraine, Stewards permitted Ms M Kinny to be substituted as the rider of the mare.

**Uno Best** – Was a little slow to begin.

**Denman Flyer** – Was a little slow to begin. Passing the 800m was restrained from the heels of Brimstone (app J Richards) which shifted in when not quite clear. App J Richards was advised to exercise more care.

**Marquee** – Slow to begin. Laid in in the straight.

**Moss My Name** – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a poor recovery rate. Trainer Mr M Gee subsequently reported that the mare had developed a cough on return to his stables. He added that the mare would now be retired from racing to commence stud duties.

**Lazyaxl** – Hung out near the 600m which afford Janis a run to its inside. Trainer Mr T Sutherland was told a warning would be recorded against the racing manners of the gelding.

**RACE 7: Dunstan And Smith Commercial Vinyl Laying Class 2 Handicap 1200m**

**Lessyd** – Change of tactics: To be ridden more forward; settled just off pace.

**Serging Rush** – Slow to begin.

**Melomane** – Bumped on jumping with Arrows Destiny and became unbalanced.

**Lincoln Cash Man** – Rider dropped whip passing the 300m. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding, rider app B Ryan stated that his mount did not travel at any stage of the event and in his view may not have appreciated the soft going. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in its off-fore leg (grade 1). Trainer Ms N Jarvis was told that she would be required to provide a veterinary clearance prior to being permitted to race again.

**Lilymorn** – Rider Ms M Kinny was interviewed regarding the tactics adopted on the mare. Ms Kinny stated that she had been instructed to ride her mount, which was resuming for its new stable, back in the field and as the ground was considered inferior wider, to ride her mount for luck one or two horses off the rail if possible. She added that in the early stages whilst back in the field, when the rider of Dance Harder Son which positioned to her inside commenced to ride her mount along, she elected to settle her mount behind that runner rather than being obliged to race wide in compliance with her instructions. She added that due to the early tempo being quite fast her mount tailed off and from the 600m she urged her mount along however it was inclined to lay out but also did not travel comfortably around the home turn. She added

that on straightening she applied the whip on two occasions however her mount did not respond and it was only inside the final 200m that the filly then ran home strongly. Trainer Mr J Stewart representing trainer Mr M Dale confirmed the instructions. The inquiry was adjourned. A post-race veterinary examination of the filly did not reveal any abnormality.

**Summary of whip use:**

Stewards noted the following riders exceeded the permitted strikes of the whip prior to the 100m under AR137A(5)(a)(ii). Bearing in mind the totality of whip use, no action was taken.

<b>Race 5</b>	App B Ryan ( <b>Gentleman Max</b> )	6 strikes prior to the 100m
<b>Race 5</b>	B Ward ( <b>Ziganui</b> )	7 strikes prior to the 100m (incl one consecutive).
<b>Race 5</b>	K Nisbet ( <b>Gentle Annie</b> )	6 strikes prior to the 100m
