Track: Soft (6), upgraded to a Soft (5) at 1:30pm following race 1. Upgraded to a Good (4) at 4:03pm following Race 5.

General:

App P Scorse was fined the sum of \$50 under LR68 for failing to produce a letter of authority.

RACE 1: Hotel Queanbeyan C, G & E Maiden Handicap 1000m

Skippit – Trainer Mr J Cleary was fined the sum of \$50 under AR53C(b) for failing to notify that Skippit had been gelded.

Matchfox – Bumped on jumping by Centennial Prince which shifted in.

Shady Diamond – Raced wide throughout.

Smart Remark – Trainer Mr S Cummins was spoken to regarding his failure to notify stewards of an abrasion to the gelding's left hip. The gelding was subsequently examined by the official veterinarian upon arrival at the start and passed fit to start.

Following the running of this event the track was upgraded to a Soft (5) at 1:30pm to be made retrospective to include this race.

RACE 2: Mark Hallam & Sons Builders F & M Maiden Handicap 1000m

Sirius Ascension – Shortly after the start was checked when crowded between Marry Me Molly which was tightened by Hasty Minx which shifted in and Kitty Karine which shifted out.

Miss Berlin – Passing the 700m was eased from the heels of All Mixed Up (app Ms K Jenkinson) which shifted in when not clear. Ms Jenkinson was advised to exercise more care.

All Mixed Up – Passing the 200m brushed with Cook Straight both of which shifted slight ground.

Hasty Minx – Passing the 200m hung out.

Marry Me Molly - Following the event the mare was found to have suffered a bleeding attack. As this was the second such attack, trainer Mr F Cleary was told that under the provisions of AR53A(5) the mare would incur the mandatory lifetime ban from racing in Australia.

Kitty Karine – Trainer Mr J Van Duren was advised that a warning would be recorded against the filly which hung out rounding the home turn and in the straight.

RACE 3: "Coolring" 4 The Kosciusko Class 1 Handicap 900m

Tribuna – Trainer Mr J Khalifeh was fined the sum of \$50 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identity Card for the mare.

Ariake Fire – Trainer Mr F Skerbic was fined the sum of \$50 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identity Card for the gelding.

Funky Monkey – When questioned, rider S Pollard stated that his mount which was resuming, was slow to begin and whilst it lost touch with the field in the early and middle stages, he was pleased with the fashion in which it made ground in the straight and indicated that it would now appreciate further ground. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding did not reveal any abnormality.

Going Purple – Crowded on jumping by Ariake Fire which shifted out. Passing the 150m was tightened by Brand Works which laid out and in doing so made contact with Denman Quality.

Will She Appeal – Raced wide throughout.

Dundalk – Passing the 150m had to be shifted out to obtain clear running and then laid out. Rider S Guymer was spoken to regarding failing to ride his mount out over the final two strides after the gelding had straightened.

It's Academic – Raced wide throughout. Following the event the gelding was found to have suffered a bleeding attack. As this was the second such attack, trainer Mr G Neale was told that under the provisions of AR53A(5) the gelding would incur the mandatory lifetime ban from racing in Australia.

RACE 4: Muzzleburst QRacing Horse Of The Year Class 3 Handicap 2000m

Correct weight was delayed at the request of the connections of runner-up Mirrabooka, to enable them to view the Judge's official photo finish image. After viewing that image and when satisfied with the accuracy of the placings, correct weight was declared.

Constitutional – When questioned regarding the performance of the mare, rider Ms J Taylor stated that her mount was agitated prior to the event, over-raced throughout and in her view may not have appreciated the tight circuit. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer Mr J Cleary reported that the mare had pleased in the lead up to today's event and a forward showing was anticipated. He added however that the mare had returned to the mounting enclosure with its tongue over the bit following the race. He further advised that consideration would now be given by the connections of the mare as to her racing future.

Old Man's Angel – Soon after the start momentarily attempted to buck. Trainer Ms T Bateup was told that a warning would be recorded against the gelding. Laid in in the early part of the straight.

Irenic – Held up rounding the home turn.

Justice Honor – Near the 200m had to be shifted in to continue into clear running.

RACE 5: Chelsea MacFarlane QRacing Leading Apprentice Class 1 & Maiden Plate 1600m

Myloveforlara – Slow to begin.

Whiskey'N'Diamonds – Over-raced badly throughout and passing the 900m pulled its way forward, shifted out and bumped Bingi Striker which was taken out onto Just Truckin' which was forced wider. Trainer Mr M Dale was told that a warning would be recorded against the gelding's racing manners.

Just Truckin' – When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding, rider M Bell stated that whilst his mount was obliged to race wide throughout, it nevertheless changed legs on numerous occasions and in his view was not suited to the tight circuit. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding did not reveal any abnormality.

Following the running of this event the track was upgraded to a Good (4) at 4:03pm to be made retrospective to include this race.

RACE 6: Kayla Nisbet QRacing Leading Rider F & M Benchmark 58 Handicap 1460m

Tearful Kitty – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Pahruli – When questioned regarding the performance of the mare, rider J Penza stated that his mount was under pressure from the 700m and proved most disappointing in its failure to respond to his riding at any time thereafter. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare did not reveal any abnormality.

Whispered Prayer – Raced wide throughout. Passing the 250m was hampered by Tearful Kitty which shifted in.

RACE 7: Joe Cleary QRacing Leading trainer C, G & E Benchmark 58 Handicap 1460m

Zetastar – Slow to begin.

Canford Calling – Began awkwardly.

Sparsholt – Slow to begin.

Dream On Stan – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Cherokee Warrior – Raced wide throughout.

Barrier Trial

Trainer Mr A Clarke was fined the sum of \$50 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identity Card for Ruler Of All.
