RACE 1: Electel Services Maiden Handicap 1000m

La Boum – Slow to begin. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the straight and after the 200m was eased when disappointed for a run between Meteor Gal and Genoveffa and had to be shifted out to obtain clear running.

Genoveffa – Laid in in the straight.

Meteor Gal – A post-race veterinary examination of the mare which was resuming and weakened over the final 200m did not reveal any abnormality.

RACE 2: Waratah Thoroughbreds Class 2 Handicap 1400m

Privily – Late withdrawal at 7:44am due to crack in hind hoof. Trainer Mr J Austin was advised that he would be required to provide a veterinary certificate.

Delude – Late withdrawal at 10:40am due to elevated temperature and nasal discharge. Trainer Mr D Williams was advised that he would be required to provide a veterinary certificate.

Can She Kiss – For some distance passing the 900m was inclined to over-race and got its head up when being restrained from the heels of Tennessee Tango.

Hanover Square – Held up on straightening and after the 350m was eased and shifted out to obtain clear running.

RACE 3: S & K Wilson Plumbing Benchmark 55 Handicap 2100m

Little Renegade – Began awkwardly and was bumped by Prospectors Helmet which began very awkwardly and shifted in.

Bramwell – Held up rounding the home turn and until passing the 300m. Passing the 200m was inconvenienced by Baroque (J Ford) which shifted in when not clear. J Ford was advised to exercise more care.

Prospectors Helmet – Passing the 150m was inconvenienced by From Pentridge (J Collett) which shifted in when not clear. J Collett was advised to exercise more care.

Stitched Up – Laid in in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding did not reveal any abnormality.

Foxy Touch – Was held up rounding the home turn.

RACE 4: Weddings & Functions On Track Maiden Plate 1600m

Crafty Warrior – Trainer Mr K Goldman represented by Ms T Lambert was fined the sum of \$50 under LR35 for the late declaration of Ms W Costin as the rider of the filly.

Poincon – The mare, which sustained an abrasion to its near hip en route to the track, was examined by the club's veterinary officer and passed fit to start.

Rapture Miss – Change of tactics: To be ridden more forward; slow to begin and bumped by Busker's Ballad which shifted in and settled handy.

Poincon – Slow to begin.

Io's Orbit – Slow to begin.

Momentum To Win – Held up approaching the home turn.

Plus Belle La Vie – Held up in the early part of the straight and passing the 250m after shifting to the inside of Busker's Ballad had to be eased from the heels of that runner when it rolled back in.

Crafty Warrior – A post-race veterinary examination of the filly did not reveal any abnormality.

RACE 5: Douglass Blinds & Security Screens Class 1 Handicap 1200m

Our Rosemaree – Slow to begin. Near the 900m had to be restrained from the heels of O'So Tempting which was being restrained when racing fiercely.

Bare Foot Babe – Knuckled over on jumping.

The Greatest – A little slow to begin and then inconvenienced by O'So Tempting which shifted in. Held up in the early part of the straight and had to be shifted to the inside of Creative Vision to obtain clear running. Laid out over the final 100m.

O'So Tempting – Raced fiercely in the early stages.

RACE 6: Storage King Goulburn Benchmark 58 handicap 1200m

Chuck'N'Paul – Soon after the start was crowded by Fortune Star which laid in.

Fortune Star – Laid in over the final 200m.

Lulu Raez – When questioned regarding the performance of the mare, rider Ms K Mallyon stated that her mount was most disappointing and raced flat throughout. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare did not reveal any abnormality. Stable representative Ms T Lambert advised that in light of today's performance the mare would be given a let-up.

Messiah's Jewel – Rider M Cahill was spoken to regarding returning to scale 400 grams beneath his mounts allotted weight.

RACE 7: Country Championship @ Goulburn 24 Feb Maiden Handicap 1200m

Tiara Road – Late withdrawal at 9:25am due to elevated temperature and nasal discharge. Trainer Mr D Williams was advised that he would be required to provide a veterinary certificate.

Hellyers Road – Trainer Mr D Williams was fined the sum of \$50 under LR35 for the late declaration of J Ford as the rider of the filly. A post-race veterinary examination of the filly did not reveal any abnormality.

Euro Gold – Slow to begin and hampered shortly after by Posh Arli which was taken out by American Honor. Passing the 150m was eased and shifted to the outside of the heels Read All About It (P Wells) which shifted in when not quite clear. P Wells was reprimanded under AR137(a).

Posh Arli – Hampered on jumping by American Honor which shifted out. Over-raced in the early stages.

American Honor – Raced wide throughout.

Mistress Mace – Raced wide throughout.

Read All About It – Began awkwardly, shifted out and crowded Bullseye Score.

Amelda – Passing the 50m when weakening was taken in by Posh Arli (app R King) and had to be eased from that runner’s heels. App Ms R King was reprimanded under AR137(a).

Summary of whip use:

Stewards noted the following riders exceeded the permitted strikes of the whip prior to the 100m under AR137A(5)(a)(ii). Bearing in mind the totality of whip use, no action was taken.
