Race 1: Maiden Plate 1100m

Retreat Star – Hung out rounding the home turn and when under pressure in the straight.

Race 2: Class 2 Trophy Handicap 1200m

Mahlia – Hung out rounding the home turn. Laid out under pressure passing the 100m.

The Clash – When questioned rider S Fogg stated that his mount failed to travel at any stage of the race and resented the kick back on the dirt track. Trainer Mr B Dixon stated that it would now be his intention to avoid racing the gelding on dirt surfaces. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

Hart Burn – Trainer Mr A Vine was advised that a warning would be recorded against the gelding for uncompetitive after it was beaten 31.53 lengths. Mr Vine stated that Hart Burn would now leave his stable.

Race 3: Class 1 Trophy Handicap 1400m

Festival of Light – Slow to begin. Rider R Wilson was fined \$200 (AR137A(5)(a)(ii)) for using his whip on 9 occasions prior the 100m.

Choppa – Slow to begin. Near the 1000m was steadied after improving onto the heels of *Anglebury*.

No Cussin – Trainer Mr A Vine was advised that the gelding which was beaten 30.65L and which laid in badly in the middle stages would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of stewards before being permitted to race again.

Time To Tango – Late scratching at 12:28pm when no rider was available.

Anglebury – Slow to begin. Near the 400m was checked and bumped heavily with the running rail when crowded inside *No Cussin* which laid in despite the efforts of its rider. Rider Ms K Spalding suffered bruising to her right foot in the incident and was stood down from her remaining engagements.

One Eye Watching – Slow to begin.

Miss Peyton – Late scratching at 12:28pm when no rider was available.

Race 4: Marthaguy Picnic Cup 1400m:

Consented – Late scratching at 12:28pm when no rider was available.

Rena's Lad – Late scratching at 3:20pm after rider Ms K Spalding became indisposed and no other rider was available.

Track Flash – Slow to begin.

Hyacintha – Began awkwardly and shifted in crowding *Didyahearme*.

Didyahearme – Laid out under pressure passing the 200m.

Race 5: Class 3 Trophy Handicap 800m:

Billy Bent Ear – Checked on jumping and lost ground (3L) when crowded by *Jessie Prevails* which began awkwardly and shifted in.
