Supplementary Report

Dubbo, Friday 16th August 2019

Race 6: LAZY SUNDAY LIFESTYLE BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP 1610m:

My Friend Charlie- Stewards today continued their inquiry into the death of **My Friend Charlie** in the abovementioned race after the gelding collapsed suddenly shortly after the event. Evidence was taken from trainer Mr. S. Gleeson, who provided treatment and veterinary records for the relevant period for **My Friend Charlie** as well as the official race day veterinarian Dr Kevin Doyle who provided an immediate report detailing a determination of Exercise-Associated Cardiorespiratory failure being the cause of the collapse. Stewards also tendered the results of a post mortem sample that was obtained from **My Friend Charlie** shortly after the gelding's death that was conducted by the Australian Forensic Laboratory, which failed to reveal any banned substances that may have been administered to **My Friend Charlie**. As the stewards were satisfied that there was no pre-existing condition that may have contributed to the incident, the inquiry was concluded.

Race 1: Daily Liberal Melbourne Cup Day Maiden Handicap 1000m:

Rusty Ginger Meggs – Began awkwardly and shortly after bumped with *Valen Galtero* resulting in both runners becoming very unbalanced.

Charlie Flyer – Slow to begin. Near the 800m was steadied after improving onto the heels of *Ruby Lil*. Hung out rounding the home turn and was steadied away from the heels of *Ruby Lil*.

The Sprooker – On jumping bumped with *Valen Galtero*.

Sweepero – Was a late scratching at 1:17pm by order of the stewards acting on veterinary advice after the filly was found to have a large abrasion to the off side hip. Stewards ordered that all bets placed on *Sweepero* be refunded and all successful bets placed with bookmakers prior to 1:17pm be subject to the following deductions.

1st – *All Hollywood* – 0 cents win
1 cent place
2nd – *The Sprooker* – 1 cent place
3rd – *Clever Missile* - 1 cent place

Trainer Mr T McIntosh was fined \$300 AR105(1)(d) for failing to report a condition which may have affected the performance of the filly. Trainer Mr T McIntosh was advised a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to the filly racing or trialling again.

Ruby Lil – Hung out and raced ungenerously in the early stages.

Valen Galtero – A post race veterinary examination of the gelding which was beaten 25.22L failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Stable representative Mr M Lunn was advised to report on the post race condition of the gelding before a determination would be made on the immediate racing future of **Valen Galtero**.

Race 2: Chill-Rite Daikin Christmas Race Day Open Handicap 1400m:

My Tagoson – Slow to begin.

Free Billy – Slow to begin.

Buon Natale – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

George Two – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 3: McDonalds Dubbo & Wellington Benchmark 58 Handicap 2200m:

Bemboka – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Outta Space – Rider App Ms Y Lewis was reprimanded under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using the whip on 10 occasions prior to the 100m.

Subway Surfer – Underwent a pre race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

Andante – On jumping was crowded by *Carinda Road* which began awkwardly and shifted out.

Dizzy Success – Laid out under pressure in the straight.

Royal Abbey – Rider App Ms M Weir was reprimanded under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using the whip on 10 occasion prior to the 100m. Raced wide in the middle stages.

Arraign – Underwent a pre race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

Race 4: Foodies Race Day Maiden Plate 1300m:

A Krupt Pick – Near the 50m laid out and bumped with *Love's A Hit*.

Beleura Demon – Laid out under pressure in the straight.

Pardon Me – Slow to begin.

Loves A Hit – OVERRACED in the early stages.

Sagacious Savant – Slow to begin.

Race 5: HIT93.5 Derby Day Benchmark 66 Handicap 1000m:

Mauí Princess – Began awkwardly. Near the 350m shifted out and bumped with *Sons Of Bourke*. A post race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a slower than normal recovery rate.

Squared - Near 800m was steadied after improving onto the heels of *Mauí Princess*.

Drummed Out – Began awkwardly.

Race 6: Fashion Series Gala Ball Class 1 & Maiden Plate 1600m

Grosvenor Bridge – Slow to begin. Raced wide in the middle stages.

Mount Taishan – Slow to begin.

Harrietta – Raced wide throughout.

Moment Of Hope – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Megalodon – Near the 200m was steadied for some distance after laying in onto the heels of *Brave Maddie* and then had difficulty obtaining clear running until after the 100m when held up for clear running between *Voyages* and *Brave Maddie*.

Fleur De Force - Between the 200m and 100m had difficulty obtaining clear running when held up on the heels of *Megalodon*.

Lithely – Near the 1400m improved onto the heels of *Fleur De Force* and had to be checked.

Race 7: Rumble At The Race Course Benchmark 58 Handicap 1300m:

Mr Hussill - Slow to begin.

Proudest Moment - Began awkwardly and shifted in bumping *Five Star Gal*. Near the 200m was steadied when disappointed for a run between *Five Star Gal* and *Rehanaat* (D Northey) which shifted out when not clear. D Northey was reprimanded AR131(a)

Miss Lon - Slow to begin. Near the 200m improved onto the heels of *Audio Bay* and shifted in, to improve into clear running.

Oracabessa - Slow to begin.

Race 8: Commercial Hotel Class 1 Handicap 1000m:

What The Fuss - Blundered on jumping.

Tombolo - Slow to begin.

Dart Street - On jumping was crowded by *Rufio* which began awkwardly and shifted in.

Captain Material – Near the 800m was checked when crowded by *Mo's Glory* which was carried in by *Vanzant* (R Yetimova) which shifted in when not clear. R Yetimova was reprimanded AR131(a).

Moon Over Menah - Blundered on jumping.

Summary of whip use:

Stewards noted the following riders exceeded the permitted strikes of the whip prior to the 100m under AR132(7)(a)(ii). Bearing in mind the totality of whip use, no action was taken.

Race 2	R Thompson (My Tagoson) A Bullock (Attalea)	6 strikes prior to the 100m. 6 strikes prior to the 100m.
Race 4	B Cray (Private Poet)	6 strikes prior to the 100m.
Race 6	A Cavallo (Boult)	7 strikes prior to the 100m.
Race 7	G Ryan (Ben Shoof)	7 strikes prior to the 100m.
