

STEWARDS REPORT

Gilgandra Turf Club GILGANDRA RACECOURSE

Race 1: INLAND PETROLEUM MAIDEN HANDICAP 1280m:

So Good To Me – Trainer Mr C Lundholm was fined \$100 under AR59A failing to provide the thoroughbred identity card for the filly when required. Near the 600m was bumped and became unbalanced by *See For Yourself* which shifted out. A post race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be 1/5 lame in the off foreleg. Trainer C Lundholm advised the filly will now be spelled.

A Krupt Pick – A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a slower than normal recovery rate and respiratory distress. Trainer W Collison was advised a veterinary certificate including the results of an endoscopic examination would be required prior to the gelding racing again.

Alexandra Demure – Raced wide throughout.

Geegee Boom – A post race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame (4/5) in the near foreleg. Trainer D Lunn was advised the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of stewards and a veterinary certificate of fitness would also be required.

Secret Thoughts – Crowded shortly after the start by *Wee Lassie*.

Wee Lassie – Steadied near the winning post after hanging out onto the heels of *See For Yourself*.

Race 2: KELLY & ASTILL LEN KELLY MEMORIAL MAIDEN PLATE 1100m:

Ready's Best – Late scratching at 1:40pm by order of the stewards when the gelding refused to load into the barriers. Stewards ordered that all bets placed on *Ready's Best* be refunded and all successful bets placed with Bookmakers be ordered to be paid less the following deductions.

1st Miranda Kay – 0 cents win
5 cents place

2nd Dynasty Di – 4 cents place

2nd Miss Lon – 2cents place

Trainer C Thurston was advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of stewards on two consecutive occasions prior to racing again.

Valarian – Trainer A Molloy was fined the sum of \$100 under AR59A failing to provide the thoroughbred identity card for the gelding when required. App Ms K Bell Pitomac pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) in that she permitted her mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of Valarian which was carried out onto the heels of Miss Lon and was checked after losing its rightful running. App K Bell Pitomacs' license to ride in races was

suspended for a period to commence 14th January 2019 and to expire 21st January 2019 on which she may ride.

Clarion – Slow to begin.

Dynasty Di – Near the 250m was steadied and shifted out after being disappointed for a run inside *Miranda Kay*.

Indigo Moon – Near the 600m was bumped by *Miss Lon* which shifted out.

Riverina Princess – Rider P Payne advised that his saddle had slipped near the 900m placing him at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer Mr C Maxwell was advised a warning for being uncompetitive would be recorded against the filly which was beaten 26.49L.

Race 3: WIDELAND & CONSTRUCTION – CPS THOMAS BALLHAUSEN IRVIN BM 66 HCP 1280m:

Attalea – Overraced in the early stages.

Go Beau Jangles – Raced wide throughout. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Bergdorf – Slow to begin.

Amaretto – Began Awkwardly.

Dunderry – A post race veterinary examination revealed a slower than normal recovery rate.

Race 4: GILGANDRA SERVICES CO-OP LIMITED COO-EE CUP – CLASS 2 m:

Bossy Rose – A post race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be coughing and displaying respiratory distress. Trainer Mr M Plummer was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness including the results of an endoscopic examination would be required before the mare is permitted to race again.

Snappy Diamond – Crowded shortly after the start by *Born To Power* which laid out. Near the 150m was steadied and shifted in after improving onto the heels of *Percussion*.

Press Reset – A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame (2/5) in the near hind leg. Trainer Mr C Thurston was advised a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to the gelding racing again.

Strike Zone – Raced wide in the middle stages. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5: GILGANDRA NEWSPAPER BOB FORAN MEMORIAL GILGANDRA TOW PLATE 1100m:

A Martin Placepick – Blundered shortly after the start.

Larlabrook – Near the 200m was steadied when crowded by *Tully Ho* which was carried out by *Fine Hero*. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding rider M Cahill stated that his mount travelled well until near the 600m where when placed under pressure it failed to respond to his riding. M Cahill added that after receiving a bump near the 200m his mount weakened from that point and was disappointing. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be displaying signs of tying up. Trainer Mr C Lundholm was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required before the gelding is permitted to race again.

Lucienne – Laid in under pressure in the early stages of the straight.

Tully Ho – Began Awkwardly.

Race 6: GILGANDRA TOYOTA HAPPY 80TH BIRTHDAY CATHIE WATTS CLASS 2 HANDICAP 1200m:

Angel's Scent – Late scratching at 4:06pm by order of the stewards when the mare refused to be loaded into the barriers. Stewards ordered that all bets placed on *Angel's Scent* be refunded and all successful bets placed with Bookmakers be ordered to be paid less the following deductions.

1st Miss Hugo A Gogo – 2 cents win
2 cents place

2nd Future Road – 3 cents place

3rd Northern Conqueror – 3 cents place

Trainer Mr S Sampson was advised the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to racing again.

Party Bag – Crowded shortly after the start by *Miss Hugo A Gogo* which was taken out by *Northern Conqueror*.

Northern Conqueror – Rider Ms T Jeffries pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(a) in that near the 600m she permitted her mount *Tennessee Man* to shift in when insufficiently clear of *Northern Conqueror* which was checked. Ms T Jeffries license to ride in race was suspended for a period to commence immediately and to expire 13th January 2019 on which day she may ride.

Bel Attrait – Near the 150m improved onto the heels of *Tennessee Man* and was shifted out to improve into clear running.

Race 7: GILGANDRA SPORTING CLUB GILGANDRA CUP 1600M:

A Magic Zariz – A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame (3/5) in the near foreleg. Trainer C Hodgson advised the gelding will now be spelled.

Baroque Girl – Slow to begin.

Any Blinkin Day – Hung out passing the 1300m and carried *Baroque Girl* and *A Magic Zariz* wider.

Loves A Hassle – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

Something Borrowed – Slow to begin.

Douro – For some distance near the 800m the gelding made contact with the running rail and became very unbalanced losing ground.

Race 8: ARMATREE HOTEL AHRENS BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP 1100M

Bee Double Bee – Began awkwardly and lost ground.

Handful Of Aces – Slow to begin.

Hey Billy Boy – Trainer D Lunn was advised a warning for a poor performance would be placed on the record of the gelding which was beaten 13.82L. Mr Lunn advised that Hey Billy Boy would now leave his stable.
