**Riding Changes:**

Race 1: B Cray replaced C Gallagher (injured)  
Race 2: B Cray replaced C Gallagher  
Race 6: B Cray replaced C Gallagher  
Race 7: S Lisnyy replaced C Gallagher

**Race 1: Maiden Plate 1000m**

**Hey Wayne** – had to be checked when over racing behind Splasher when the tempo eased passing the 700m, then hung out.

**Supposedly Wicked** – dislodged its rider during the parade to the start and was scratched after completing a circuit of the course rider less.

**Foreign Brother** – hung in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**Levi's Storm** – had to be steadied and shifted out when the tempo slackened near the 700m, then raced greenly in restricted room when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**Taketheshot** – began awkwardly.

**Mook's Sister** – scratched on the advice of the RacingNSW Official Veterinary Officer after examination at the start revealed the filly was 3/5 lame in the near hind leg. When correct weight was declared it was ordered that all bets made on Supposedly Wicked and Mook's Sister be refunded in full and with regard to betting with bookmakers, all successful wagers placed prior to 1.43pm be subject to the following deduction on the face value of the betting ticket:

1<sup>st</sup> Splasher – 0 cents Win & 3 cents Place

2<sup>nd</sup> Ranuncula – 1 cent Place

3<sup>rd</sup> Taketheshot – 3 cents Place

Further it was ordered that all successful wagers made between 1.43pm and 1.46pm be subject to the following deduction on the face value of the betting ticket:

1<sup>st</sup> 0 cents Win & 1 cent Place

2<sup>nd</sup> 1 cent Place

3<sup>rd</sup> 1 cent Place

Trainer Mr. T O'Neile was advised that prior to racing again, Mook's Sister must undergo a veterinary examination to determine its suitability to race.

### **Race 2: Maiden Handicap 1200m**

**We All Agree** – began awkwardly and was slow away, then raced intractably in the early stages and was continually steadied.

**Hurn Court** – hung in when placed under pressure in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality. Trainer Mrs. S Grills said that Hurn Court would be spelled.

**Dublin Bay** – reared at the start and lost ground (2L).

**Ringo's Charm** – slow to begin.

**Spring Nymph** – raced without cover throughout.

**Port Of Jeddah** – was crowded passing the 250m.

### **Race 3: Maiden Plate 1600m**

**At The Cove** – slow to begin, then raced without cover.

**Casa De Reign** – slow to begin.

**Fiji Warrior** – over raced during the middle stages.

**Under The Pump** – hung in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

### **Race 4: Benchmark 58 Handicap 1600m**

**Shame Warned** – slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality. Trainer Mr. S Jones said that whilst recovery would be monitored, he would recommend to connections that the gelding be spelled.

**The Juke** – was treated post-race by the RacingNSW Official Veterinarian suffering a locked stifle.

**Maui Princess** – when questioned regarding his ride between the 600m and the home turn G Ryan Explained that at this stage of the race he was satisfied with his position in relation to the bulk of the field and stated that he was in a position to chase the leader after entering the straight. He said that he allowed Maui Princess to race without being pressured during this time as his mount was up in distance and he intended to maximize its response to enable it to increase the break between it and Shame Warned inside the 400m. He said that after entering the home straight Maui Princess responded for a short distance, then weakened from the 150m.

#### **Race 5: Class 3 Handicap 1400m**

Trainer Mr. C Crockett was fined \$100 (LR35) for failing to declare A Cavallo as the rider of Entreat by the prescribed time.

**Mystic Splendour** – raced without cover.

**Entreat** – slow to begin.

**Damit** – when questioned K Jennings explained that he had been instructed to obtain cover in the early stages. He said that his mount began well, however after being crossed by Schappose approaching the 1200m he was placed slightly further back than intended. He said that after this despite travelling well throughout Damit was unresponsive when placed under pressure and disappointing in its finishing effort. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.

**Laughs Loudest** – was forced to alter course to go forward near the 200m.

**Burley Park** – scratched at 3.24pm when it was observed that a muscle massaging device was fitted to the gelding in the race day stalls. Trainer Mr. M Gwynne was fined \$200 (AR233a) for administering this particular race day treatment to the gelding in the tie up stalls.

#### **Race 6: Class 2 Handicap 1200m**

Trainer Mrs. S Grills was fined \$100 LR35 for failing to declare G Ryan as the rider of Untamed Mistress by the prescribed time.

**Brave Enough** – struck the heels of Lagarde when the pace steadied near the 1000m and had to be checked severely. Was treated post-race by the

RacingNSW Official Veterinarian after sustaining a small laceration to its off fore cannon.

**Lagarde** – had to be checked when the pace steadied near the 1000m.

**Hardyo** – raced wide without cover.

**Leave Me Some** – raced ungenerously for some distance in the middle stages.

**New York Nick** – had to be steadied near the 1000m. D Gibbons, the rider of Brave Enough, pleaded guilty in the presence of RacingNSW Apprentice Mentor, Mr. S Thurlow to a charge under AR131a, stating that he engaged in careless riding by allowing his mount to shift in and crowd Fleeting Princess into the path of **New York Nick**, which struck the heels of Fleeting Princess and blundered. D Gibbons' permit to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence Thursday 17/9/20 and expire 21/9/20, on which day he may resume.

**Mathematics** – slow to begin, raced ungenerously in the middle stages, then had to be checked and shifted out abruptly after failing to obtain a narrow run near the 250m.

**Luvdisc** – missed the start (2L).

**Fleeting Princess** – sustained an abrasion to its off hind leg during the race.

#### **Race 7: Open Handicap 1200m**

**Ligulate** – began awkwardly with its head up. When questioned D Gibbons explained that he was instructed to ride his mount in its usual rearward position where it was comfortable. He said that to avoid being trapped wide in the early stages he restrained to the rear of the field and raced adjacent to the running rail. He said that approaching the 900m he had obtained the back of Manabar, which he felt was a runner capable of providing him a path when improving into the race and passing the 600m when Manabar was being urged forward he shifted to its outside, placed his mount under pressure and despite being forced wide rounding the home turn, ligulate responded strongly and ran to the finish well. Hung in under pressure over the concluding stages.

**Manabar** – slow to begin, then was hampered and had to be steadied near the 900m.

**Ayham** – was hampered and had to be eased near the 900m.

**Cosmic Reign** – R Jones, the rider of Heaven's High, in the presence of RacingNSW Apprentice Mentor, Mr. S Thurlow, pleaded guilty to a charge under AR131a, stating that he engaged in careless riding by allowing his mount to shift in near the 900m, when insufficiently clear of **Beacon**, which was crowded onto **Desert Marshall**, which had to be checked and lost ground, with **Beacon** being further carried inward onto **All From Scrap**, which was crowded onto **Arleta**, which was forced into the path of **Cosmic Reign**, which struck the heels of Arleta and had to be checked severely. R Jones' permit to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence Monday 21/9/20 and expire Monday 28/9/20, on which day he may resume.
