**Race 1: Maiden Handicap 1200m**

**Run Angel Run** – slow to begin.

**Onkaparinga** – the saddle slipped forward passing the 800m which placed its rider at a significant disadvantage.

**Paddy Winter** – slow to begin.

**Race 2: Benchmark 50 Handicap 1200m**

**Just Imagine** – had to be steadied passing the 600m.

**Blinkin Snazzy** – slow to begin.

**Grey Piranha** – hampered and steadied passing the 600m. Following a request from the trainer Mr. D Want, that Grey Piranha be declared a non-runner because of being denied a fair start, it was conceded that whilst the gates on the barrier stall from which Grey Piranha began were marginally slow to open, resulting in the gelding missing the start by approximately 1 length, this occurrence being considered with the running of the race and the manner of Grey Piranha's performance, did not materially effect its chances of finishing in the first four placings, therefore Grey Piranha was declared a runner.

**Tudor Sunrise** – slow to begin.

**Race 3: Maiden Plate 1400m**

**Thellyson** – slow to begin.

**Race 4: Class 1 Handicap 1400m**

**Paper Kites** – began awkwardly and was slow away.

**Race 5: Benchmark 77 Handicap 1400m**

**Marenostro** – slow to begin.

**Free Billy** – slow to begin, then raced wide without cover throughout.

**Race 6: Benchmark 50 Handicap 1600m**

**Rahdane** – slow to begin.

**Happens Nomore** – was continually held up approaching and rounding the home turn, then had to be checked and shifted out to go forward passing the 150m. When questioned in relation to her ride between the 1100m and the 900m W Peel explained that she had been instructed to ride her mount where it was comfortable in a forward position, with leading an option. She said that Happens Nomore blundered at the start and settled behind the lead at a slow tempo. She said that near the 1100m she was able to improve along the running rail on the inside of Prince Of Baroda, however at this point the rider of Prince Of Baroda increased the tempo and crossed to the running rail and because of this she elected to ride with cover. Trainer Mr. P Sinclair confirmed the instructions. After considering all the circumstances including the stage of the race where W Peel decided to ease to allow Prince Of Baroda to cross, no direct action was taken, however she was advised in the presence of her master Mrs. S Grills, that her decision to allow Prince Of Baroda to cross her near the 1000m lacked initiative and was the direct cause of Happens Nomore being unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the remainder of the race. Further, W Peel was told that had she maintained a position inside Prince Of Baroda from the 1000m, Happens Nomore would have won.
