**Race 1: 3YO Maiden Plate 1100m**

**Barry's Brother** – over raced during the middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.

**Dynasty Di** – over raced during the middle stages.

**Kinks** – slow to begin.

**Macal** – began awkwardly and was slow away.

**Race 2: Open Handicap 1200m**

**Gadfly** – began awkwardly and was slow away.

**Race 3: Maiden Handicap 1200m**

**Cutie Patoutie** – raced fiercely when trapped wide without cover in the early stages.

**Khitaamy** – over raced during the early stages.

**Dukes County** – began awkwardly, then raced greenly throughout.

**Mr Piquet** – was fractious in the barrier and withdrawn on veterinary advice at 2.55pm. When correct weight was declared, it was ordered that all bets made on Mr Piquet be refunded in full and with regard to betting with bookmakers, all successful wagers placed prior to 2.55pm be subject to the following deduction on the face value of the betting ticket:

1<sup>st</sup> Montana Pines – 20 cents Win & 18 cents Place

2<sup>nd</sup> Khitaamy – 14 cents Place

3<sup>rd</sup> Dicko's Mate – 22 cents place

Taking into account all the circumstances, including the loading procedure for this event, stable representative Mr. K Forbes was advised that a warning for being fractious in the barrier would be placed on the gelding's racing record.

**Azarmin** – was crowded at the start, then raced greenly when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**Chance Of Rain** – hung out when placed under pressure in the home straight.

**Agua** – began awkwardly.

#### **Race 4: Maiden Plate 1450m**

**Any Chance Darl** – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding was sore over the back. Trainer Mr. M Brunner was advised that prior to racing again Any Chance Darl must undergo a veterinary examination to determine its fitness.

**Boston Blues** – had to be checked after improving into restricted room near the 1200m.

**Mr Intrepid** – was bumped at the start.

**Not A Word** – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding was 2/5 lame in the near fore leg. Trainer Mr L Thomas was advised that a prior to racing again Not A Word must undergo a veterinary examination to determine its fitness.

**Road To Bordeaux** – slow to begin.

**Atomic Lass** – ran wide under pressure inside the 200m.

**Soho Flyer** – bumped at the start.

**Go Lassie Go** – raced wide without cover throughout.

**Race 5: Class 1 Handicap 1000m**

**Good Grab** – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.

**Honour Your Offer** – slow to begin.

**Slimline** – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly displayed a poor recovery. Trainer Mr P Farrell was advised that prior to racing again Slimline must undergo a veterinary examination to determine its fitness.

**Blinkin Dancing** – clipped the heels of Good Grab passing the 800m, blundered and almost fell.

**Race 6: Class 3 Handicap 1600m**

**Magic Name** – ran wide under pressure in the home straight. Cast its off fore plate during the race.

**Bunny Bad Girl** – slow to begin, then was bumped heavily passing the 600m, became very unbalanced and lost ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.

**Mishani Istana** – was slow to begin and shifted out abruptly.

**Sealum** – when questioned in relation to the altered riding tactics, trainer Mr N Mitchell stated that he had always issued instruction to have the gelding ridden aggressively early to obtain a forward position in its races, as was the case today. He said that in his opinion the removal of ear muffs and the addition of Blinkers aided the rider to achieve this today and said that he would continue to issue similar instructions to whoever rode Sealum in future.

**Race 7: Benchmark 58 Handicap 1200m**

**Yambaah Prince** – slow to begin.

**I Can Hear Music** – slow to begin, then bounded roughly and became unbalanced passing the 1000m.

**Asudem** – over raced during the middle stages, then hung in rounding the home turn and in the early part of the home straight.

**Manabar** – slow to begin.

<b>Race 2: L Day – Brotherly Secret</b>	8 strikes prior to the 100m
<b>Race 5: L Day – Malzoom</b>	6 strikes prior to the 100m
<b>Race 6: R Jones – Mishani Istana D McLellan – Flymia Miss</b>	6 strikes prior to the 100m 7 strikes prior to the 100m
<b>Race 7: L Day – Yambaah Prince</b>	7 strikes prior to the 100m

Considering the totality of use, no action was taken.
