**Race 2: Animalcare Health & Performance Supplies Class 2 Handicap – Rising Star 1500m**

**Roman** – App P Scorse was fined the sum of \$200 under AR127(1) for failing to fulfil this riding engagement.

**RACE 1: Barlens Hire Maiden Plate 1000m**

**Serb Alert** – Contacted on jumping by Aeecee Dynasty which shifted out. Briefly held up rounding the home turn.

**Paperscissorsrock** – When questioned regarding the performance of the filly, rider Ms A Collett stated that she was instructed to obtain a position behind the speed, however when her mount began particularly well and when runners then did not go forward her mount raced further forward when it shared the lead. She added however that her mount did not travel comfortably

when dipping in the worn heavy track conditions and proved disappointing in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination of the filly did not reveal any abnormality.

**Mo More Chicken** – Hung in on straightening and until passing the 100m.

**Solva** – Near the 200m raced in restricted room for a short distance to the inside of Mo More money which was hung in despite the efforts of its rider.

**RACE 2: Kilpatrick Holdings Benchmark 58 Handicap 2140m**

No incidents.

**RACE 3: National Jockeys Trust Maiden Handicap 1400m**

**Attestar** – Rider K Jennings was permitted to ride his mount 1 kg overweight in accordance with the overweight policy.

**Crimson Jewel** – Crowded on jumping by Everjust which shifted in.

**Fattore Stella** – When questioned regarding the filly racing further back today, rider J Van Overmeire stated that as his mount had been inclined to over-race, he was instructed from his wide draw to obtain cover with the aim of assisting the filly to relax. Trainer Mr J Austin confirmed the instructions and was reminded of his obligation under the Rules to notify any change in tactics.

**RACE 4: The Kosciusko Maiden Plate 1600m**

**Ponte Pietra** – Crowded on jumping by Sir Gunsen which shifted out.

**Sir Gunsen** – Began awkwardly and knuckled soon after and shifted in.

**RACE 5: Goulburn Post Benchmark 66 Handicap 1000m**

**Takookacod** – The mare which sustained a minor laceration to its near-hind leg in its tie-up stall was examined by the Club's veterinary officer and passed fit to start.

**Glamour Cat** – Began awkwardly and shifted out.

**Nostre Re** – Contacted on jumping by My little Racer which was taken out by Turfeze.

**My Little Racer** – Contacted on jumping by Turfeze which shifted out.

**RACE 6: Goulburn Marketplace Class 1 Handicap 1000m**

**No Doubt A Star** – A pre-race veterinary examination of the gelding which contacted the enclosure fence leaving the mounting enclosure, cleared the gelding fit to start. A little slow to begin and was crowded soon after by Black Bacardi which was taken out.

**Black Bacardi** – Was bumped on jumping by Budhwar which shifted out. Rider A Sweeney was fined the sum of \$200 under AR232(6)(c) for using his whip on his mount when it was out of contention.

**Budhwar** – On jumping shifted out and bumped Black Bacardi. Rider J Van Overmeire was reprimanded under AR132(7)(a)(i) for using his whip on consecutive strides prior to the 100m.

**Moetta** – When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of the filly, rider B Spriggs stated that his mount dipped on several occasions during the race and did not race comfortably on the worn track which was rated heavy. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to have a small laceration to its off fore pastern.

**Shenandoah** – When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of the gelding, rider J Ford stated that his mount, which was resuming, did not handle today's heavy track conditions and was one-paced in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding did not reveal any abnormality.

**RACE 7: Randwick & Sthn Highlands Equine Centres F & M Benchmark 58 Handicap 1300m**

**Lake Marion** – Change of tactics: To be ridden quieter; settled to the outside and back off the leader. When questioned regarding the tactics adopted, rider app B Griffiths stated that in pre-race discussions with the trainer, as the inside ground today was regarded as worn and inferior, rather than leading and risking a runner racing to his mount's outside which may have prevented him from shifting out in search of better ground he was able to settle back off, and to the outside of the leader Sisters Esteem in accordance with his instructions.

**Addchan** – Began awkwardly, shifted in and made contact with the inside gate.

**Atomic Sunrise** – Was slow to begin.

**Georgian Court** – Over-raced with its head up for some distance in the early stages.

**RACE 8: Tash Burleigh C, G & E Benchmark 58 Handicap 1300m**

**Burrangong** – Trainer Mr J Rolfe was fined the sum of \$50 under LR35 for the late declaration of A Sweeney as the rider of the gelding.

**Chyseing Ivy** – Taken out at the start by Hard Reality which shifted out.

**Attainment** – Taken out at the start by Chyseing Ivy which was taken out.

**Supreme Lad** – Crowded on jumping by Royal Monarch which was taken out. Passing the 1100m when pulling hard, had to be restrained when it pulled its way up to the inside of Royal Monarch where there was no sufficient room, when that runner was simultaneously being eased.

**Red Hot Tango** – Soon after the start was contacted by Supreme Lad and had to be restrained out across the heels of Burrangong.

**Summary of whip use:**

Stewards noted the following riders exceeded the permitted strikes of the whip prior to the 100m under AR137A(5)(a)(ii). Bearing in mind the totality of whip use, no action was taken.
